

FleetCarma

New Geofence Charging Reports tracks kWh by location and time

[FleetCarma](#) recently introduced Geofence Charging Reports as part of its EV-integrated fleet telematics platform.

This highly requested feature provides users the time-of-day charging load from a single vehicle or group of vehicles based on predefined geo-locations (such as an office, a multi-unit residence, a home etc.).

The automated reports break-down all Level 1, Level 2, and DCFC charging, and includes kWh usage by hour of day. This capability was requested by:

- Fleets with drivers that take vehicles home and need to reimburse the drivers for home-charging.
- Fleets that want a quick snapshot of the time-of-day charging load from all their vehicles at a given building/depot.
- Multi-unit residential buildings and workplaces that want to allow EV owners to plug into 110V sockets and need to be reimbursed.

This greatly simplifies electricity usage reporting, with accessible online reports and downloadable data collected directly from the vehicles.

FleetCarma is excited to release this development as it continues to strive to be the telematics platform of choice for fleets that have or are considering electric vehicles.

The Energy Innovation Program : Demonstrations of electric vehicle infrastructure


The Energy Innovation Program has received \$46.1 million in funding over 2 years through Budget 2016, to support the demonstration of next-generation electric vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure in Canada. Accelerating clean technology development is a key component of the Government of Canada's approach to promoting sustainable economic growth and to supporting Canada's transition towards a low-carbon economy.

The **request for proposals**, originally closed on July 18, 2016, **has been extended until November 14, 2016** to allocate a remainder of six to ten million dollars, following funding allocations which resulted from the call closed on July 18. The scope and funding requirements have changed. Interested applicants are invited to submit new or revised proposals to be considered for funding under the program extension.
